What are we aiming for in 2022?

1: UPWARDS

In 2022 we would like to establish and build upon :

- Our children and families. We want to make sure our young people have an opportunity to explore their faith in a fun and age appropriate way.
- To plan services throughout the year to engage our families and community. EG: Mothers Day; Palm Sunday: Pet Service: Harvest: Crib Service.
- Ensure that every Sunday is a place where people of all ages are encouraged and have opportunities to serve and participate. **If you would like to help in some way, please speak to Rev Julie**
- To make the church and porch a place of welcome. To set up teams with badges for each Sunday. The teams to welcome, serve coffee and clear up at the end of each service. **We need more people to offer in this vital ministry of welcome. Please consider joining a team.**
- To continue building on the good work of the choir.
- New bellringers are required. Training will be provided. **We would love to hear from you if you would like to know more.**

2: INWARDS

- To grow the prayer life of the church through the sharing of the MAP at PCC and with our regular congregation.
- To encourage bible study through the joining of a homegroup or establishing a local group for Holy Trinity.
- To update our welcome pack to keep the vision and mission of Holy Trinity visible and alive.
- To grow our gift of hospitality to everyone in the church. **How do we make sure everyone feels connected?**

1 Corinthians 12:

- To employ an events co-ordinator to co-ordinate and market existing and new events in the life of the church and Trinity Hall and grounds. The hope is to hold concerts and lectures. To ensure the hall and grounds are a place suitable for baptism and wedding parties. Plans are underway for various projects and improvements to the hall and grounds. **If you would like to know more, please speak to our churchwardens.**

4: ONWARDS

As God's people we are custodians, spiritually of the faith and physically, of the buildings that enable our worship and community outreach. Money isn't everything but it is needed so we can live out our mission now and in the years to come. We need to balance our books.
